Tea Talk Outcomes Explained 24/7 URGENT CARE - TELEHEALTH UPDATE

Since Monday 14th August we have been piloting Telehealth services in partnership with Barwon Health as part of our 24/7 Urgent Care model. Telehealth uses video technology to link directly with emergency physicians at Barwon Health, to assist our nursing and clinical staff in the treatment of patients that present to the Otway Health Urgent Care Unit. As of Friday 6th October, this service has been used 30 times to assist and treat an array of acute presentations – including head and neck injuries, wounds, urinary tract infections, dog bites, chest pain and irregular heart rate. Telehealth is proving to be useful; we encourage feedback from users of the service as we continue to shape this service moving forward.
