- Board Update and Welcome -

The inaugural Otway Health GP registrar training program commenced in early February, under the stewardship of principal GP - Dr Denise Ruth and her team of senior doctors; this will strengthen primary care services in Apollo Bay for years to come. I encourage all community members to welcome and support the new medical team.

The Otway Health Board is currently completing an extensive property review to ensure we have appropriate infrastructure to support health services and accommodate current and future health professionals. Community consultation is an important part of this process and opportunities to participate will be provided in the near future.

Thank you to the many members of the community who participated in recent Otway Health 'tea-talks' and discussions at the Apollo Bay market regarding our proposal to voluntarily amalgamate with Lorne Community Hospital. Common themes identified throughout the discussions, included:

- The need to maintain and where possible improve, local access to patient services including urgent care, inpatient care, aged and residential care, and community services.
- Developing a sustainable GP service to address a major service gap in Apollo Bay.
- Retaining names for each local 'campus' Otway Health and Lorne Community Hospital.
- Ensuring structures are in place for donations and funds raised by charities, auxiliaries and bequests, to be quarantined and directed towards intended 'local' purposes.

The proposal to voluntarily amalgamate will provide recommendations that the amalgamated board include equal representation from both Otway Health and Lorne Community Hospital Boards and, to maintain local perspective, the appointment of a new member, that resides in or has strong connections with our local community. Board composition is however, ultimately at the discretion of the Minister of Health.
