NO FIRES ON GROUNDS – NO EXCEPTIONS

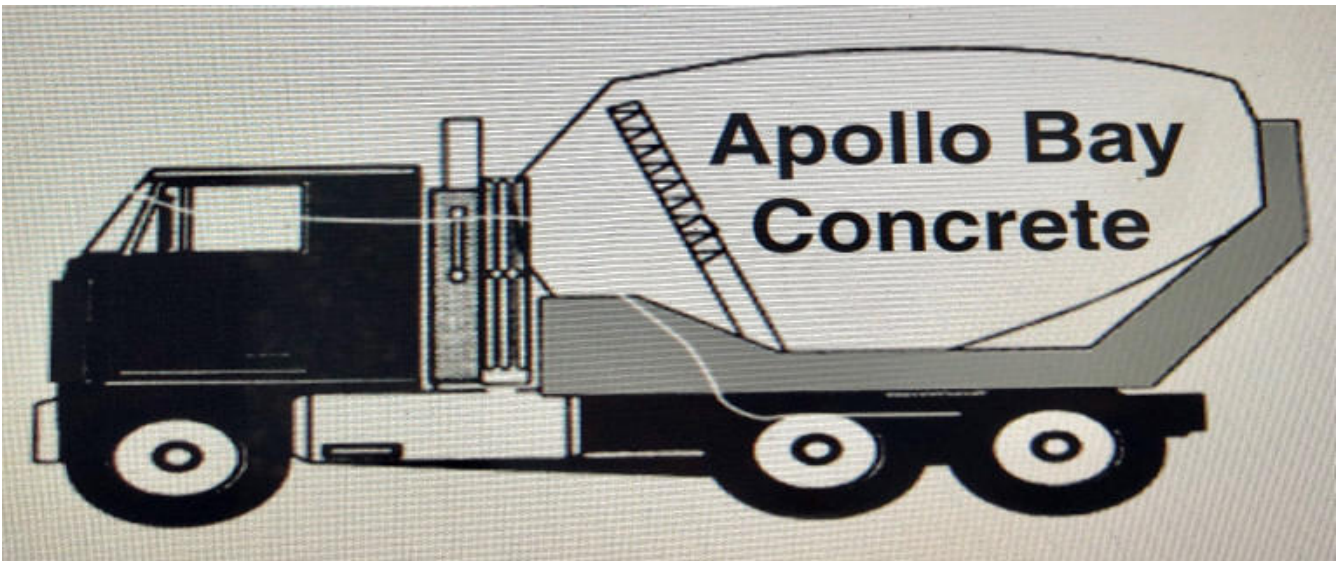

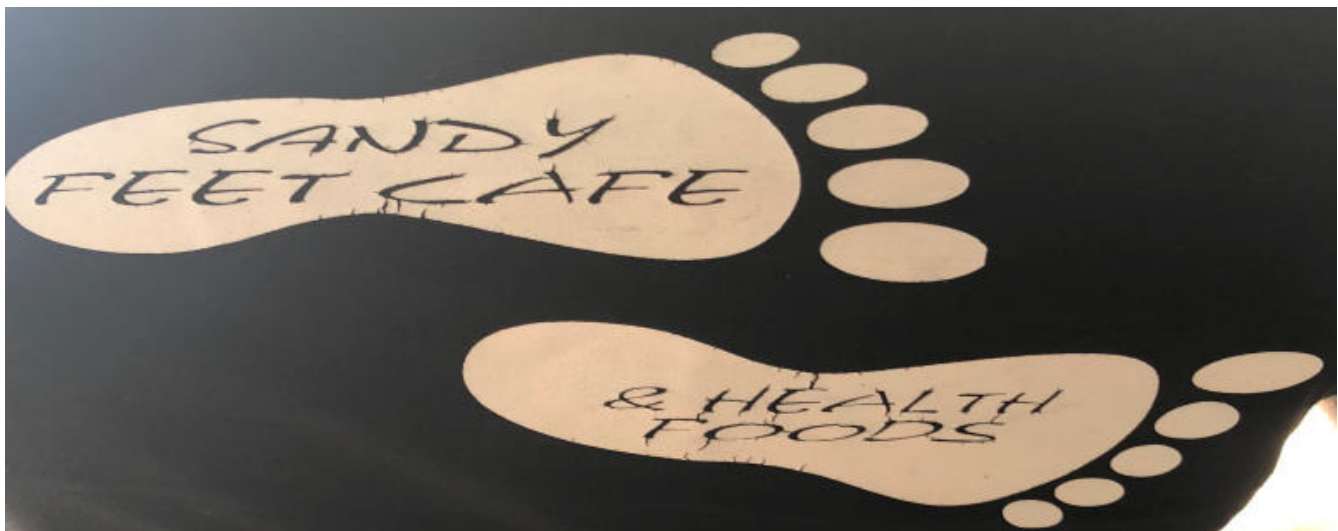

HORSE REGULATIONS

1. Entries will only be received subject to rules and regulations of the Apollo Bay and Otway District Show Society and the decisions of the Horse Committee.
2. In similar classes, the Chief Horse Steward has the right to make new classes in the event of sufficient entries, or to combine classes if there are insufficient entries.
3. Prize money indicated for competition classes is only payable for classes in which there are four or more competitors.
4. Owners entering their horses or ponies do so entirely at their own risk, and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the Society its officials or members in any respect whatsoever.
5. Where height is stipulated E.V. or R.A.S Height Certificates must be shown upon request.
6. Definitions:
 - Novice** Not having won a 1st prize competing in an Open class at an Agricultural Show.
 - Elementary** Not having won a championship at an agricultural show.
 - Intermediate** Not having won a first at a Royal Show.
 - Open** Open to all exhibitors who meet the class criteria.
 - Owner exhibitor** Horse must be prepared and exhibited by Owner as shown on registration papers, such as E.V or any Recognized Breed society or statutory declaration.
 - Veteran** over 45 years of age.
7. Random swabbing may take place.
8. In competitions based on age categories proof of age must be provided on request. Proof of Age will be accepted in the form of a birth certificate, extract of entry of birth, statutory declaration by parent, baptismal certificate or school Principal certificate. Age is at the date of the Show.
9. All riders under the age of 18 years must wear approved hardware and are not permitted to wear top boots in riding classes.
10. All riders must wear riding helmets to current Australian Standards.
11. In all Pony and Riding Club classes the following conditions apply: All competitors must be financial members of a recognized Club associated with the PCAV or HRCAV and hold a current Member's Card. Official Uniform must be worn.
12. All events to be held over such course and obstacles as the Committee may decide.
13. The breeding year dates from 1 August in each year
14. No Rigs allowed.
15. Stallions and colts are not eligible to compete in ridden classes, except where stipulated.
16. All Stallions and Colts over 2 years of age must at all time wear head-collar, bit and chain. Handlers must be over the age of 17years. Colts less than 2 years of age must be under proper restraint at all times, and preferably wear head-collar and chain.
17. All foals must be haltered in ring.
18. The term "Coloured" Horses and Ponies refers to broken- coloured animals or those registered with a recognized society.
19. No lunging on the main arena.
20. Warm-up of horses to be undertaken only in specified areas or at the direction of the Committee.
21. All rules are the discretion of the Committee who also consider the rules of EV, VASL, HRCAV, PCAV and recognized Breed Society.

Qualifier Regulations:

1. Open to all purebred freeze branded Standardbreds registered with Harness racing Australia.
2. Registered/Racing name to be used where available. Freeze brand number must be provided.
3. Qualifying shows must be VAS Ltd affiliated
4. Horse or exhibitor do not need to be registered with any other association or Breed Society other than Harness Racing Australia to be eligible to compete.
5. Qualifying classes will be judged ridden.
6. Once a Qualifier has been won, the horse is ineligible to compete in another Qualifier.
7. All Qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the HERO Series Final to be held at the VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championship.
8. Riders to be aged 14 years and over on the day of the Qualifying show.

Victorian Agricultural Shows Ltd and Apollo Bay & Otway District Agricultural Society (together 'the SUPPLIERS') advise that participation in horse sports at a agricultural show or horse competition contains elements of risk, both obvious and inherent. Horse sports are dangerous recreational activities and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially when frightened or hurt.

By signing this waiver I acknowledge that:

- Participation in horse sports is a hazardous activity and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me;
 - Participation in horse events requires certain skills. I declare that I have sufficient skills to be able to safely and properly participate in these events;
 - Horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable way, especially if frightened or hurt, or if exposed to loud and unfamiliar noises;
 - If held at a agricultural show, the horse sports will be held in close proximity to rides and large groups of people and there maybe loud and unfamiliar noises;
 - As the event is held outdoors, there are risks to me and to my horse, as a result of the weather conditions, including extreme hot or cold weather, rain or wind;
 - Insects or other animals may cause my horse or other horses to become frightened or act in a unpredicable way;
 - There is inherent in horse riding events the risk of suffering injury including falling from my horse;
 - I am responsible for ensuring that I have and will wear equipment suitable for safety and properly participating in the event and I use the facilities of Apollo Bay & Otway District Agricultural Society entirely at my own risk, as I find them and with the prior acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me.
- If I suffer harm while participating in a horse event, I will not hold the Suppliers, their employees or agents legally responsible for any injuries I suffer. I will not sue the Suppliers, their employees or agents for any claims, costs damages or liability. I agree to release the Suppliers and their employees from legal responsibility for the services I have provided.

I acknowledge and agree that my participation in the horse sports and associated activities are a danger and may have inherent risks as a result of which personal injury (and sometimes death) may occur and I accept and assume all such risks of personal injury or death in anyway whatsoever arising from these activities and hereby waive my individual right to sue the Suppliers in any way whatsoever arising from or in connection with these activities.

I will not consume any alcohol or illicit drugs while participating in the horse sports and agree that such use may result in me being excluded from an event with no entitlement to any refund of money paid for entry to the Suppliers.

I agree to be bound by the rules and guidelines of Victorian Agricultural Shows Ltd as varied from time to time.
